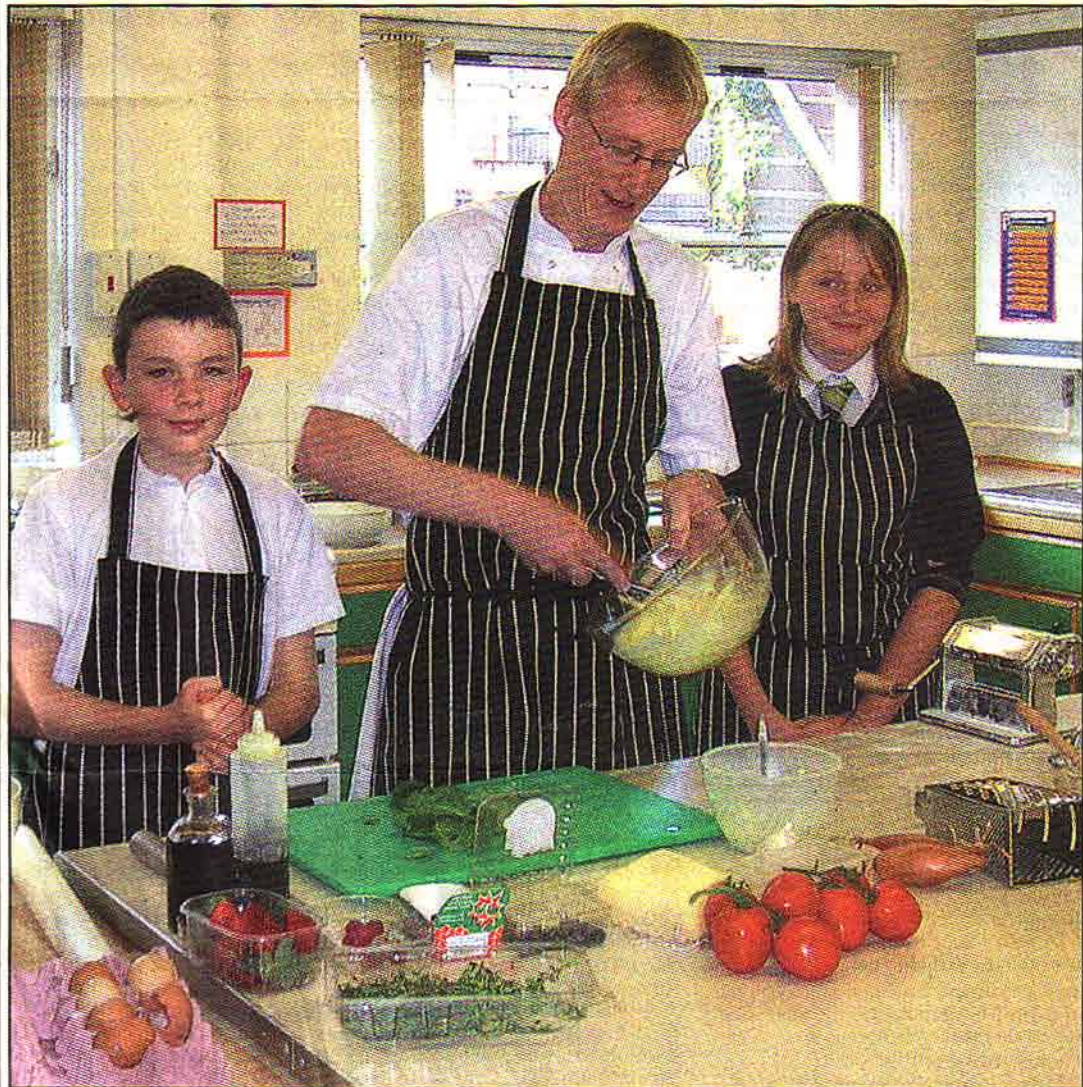


# Royalty, Man U and Minehead Middle
